4. PRIORITY VS. PREFERENCE




6. REGENERATIVE LEADERSHIP

7. TRAIN THE TRAINER - T3

This course develops participants in leadership skills to create a lasting effect on their lives and communities. Content will include but not limited to: goal setting, commitment, responsibility, purpose, relationship and emotional intelligence. Bringing awareness to human survival skills and blind spots, participants then can create alternative practices to live from a place of purpose and authenticity. They will go beyond their preconceived limitations, recognize their core intentions and values, to then take actions towards goals to create results in their lives. 
- Discover how gender bias in early childhood reaches beyond the ways we socialize; bias is embedded in the books, materials, and lessons we share, and teacher interactions with children.


OPEN-ENDED ART FOR EDUCATORS






